

# WILDFLOWERS!

Come to Edgewood County Park and Natural Preserve for a free docent-led wildflower walk.

Every Saturday and Sunday from March 14 to June 7, 2015.

Walks begin at 10 a.m. and end around 1 p.m.



Edgewood's serpentine grasslands are renowned throughout California for their lush wildflower carpets and rich biodiversity. You might see dozens of species of flowers on a single walk! Our walks vary according to what's in bloom—covering about 3 miles, at a moderate pace, with frequent stops.



Bring water, a hat, sturdy shoes, sunscreen, and a snack if you wish. Restrooms and water are available only at the main entrance. No reservations are needed unless you have a group of 10 or more. Walks start from the **Bill and Jean Lane Education Center** every weekend throughout the season.

In addition, on the four Saturdays in April (4/4, 4/11, 4/18, 4/25) walks will also start from the **Clarkia Trailhead** for easier access to the grasslands.
