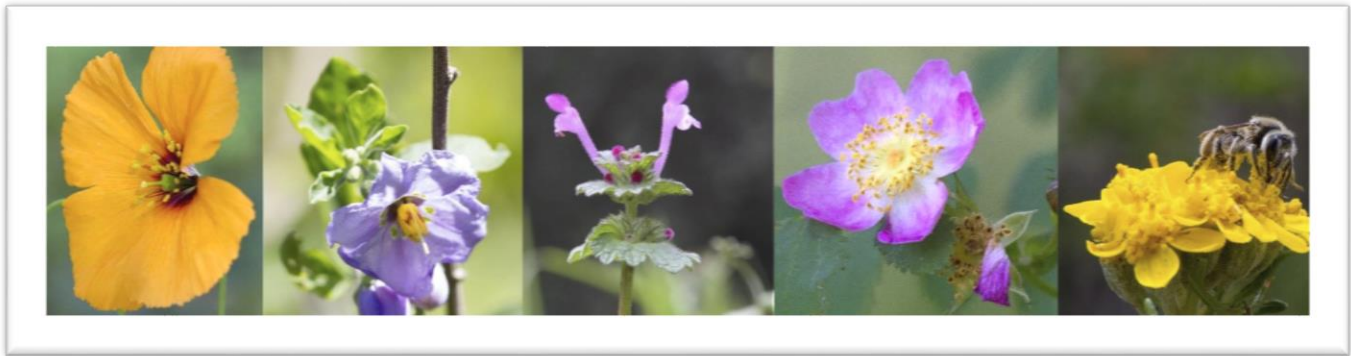


Wildflower Festival

- Activities for children: Take a close look at flowers through a magnifying glass or a microscope
